- 2 players only

In this game, players battle each other by showing one number card out of three open cards in their hands. The higher the number card is, the higher points you will get, but it becomes easier for your opponent to read your card, and harder for you to win. The lower the number card is, the easier you will win, but the lower points you will get. It is important to judge when to attack and when to defend.

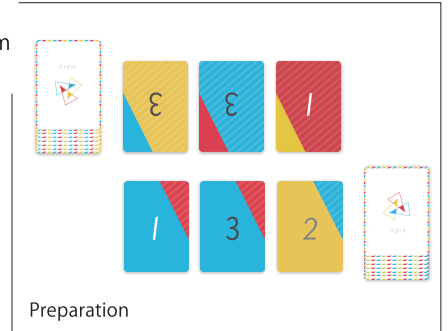

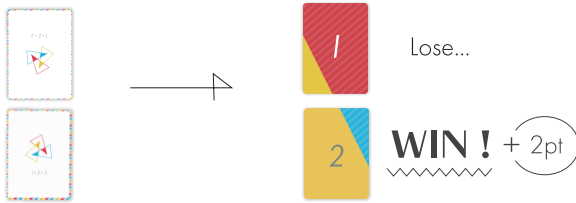
## # Preparation

Each Player receives a deck of 9 cards (Red 1-3 and Blue 1-3 and Yellow 1-3). Shuffle the deck of 9 number cards, draw three number cards from the deck, and place them face up in front of each player.



## # How to Play the Game

1. Each player chooses any number card from their hand.
2. When both players have chosen their cards, each of them puts the chosen number card face down in front of each of them.
3. Turn up the number card in front of each of them at once.



4. Determine the player who gets the points (see below), and both players replenish their hands with one number card from the deck. If there is no number card in the deck, the player does not replenish their hands.
5. Repeat the steps 1 to 4 above, and the first player to reach 3 or more points wins.

## Determining the Points

### - In case the card colors are different

The player with the superior card color gets the number on the card as the points. Red is superior to blue, blue is superior to yellow, and yellow is superior to red. The color that appears to stick out to the opponent card is visually recognized as superior.



### - In case the card colors are the same

If both players put down the cards with the same color, the player who puts down the card with the lower number gets the number on the card as the points.



### - In case the card colors and numbers are the same

If both players put down the cards with the same color and number, neither player can get the points.



## # Ending the Game

The game ends when either players has 3 or more points. The player who gets 3 or more points first wins the game. The game ends in a draw when both of the players have no more cards in their hands.
